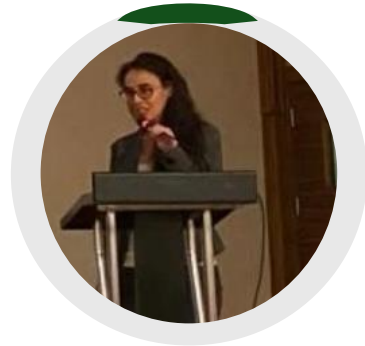
# WOMEN IN ENERGY ITALIA

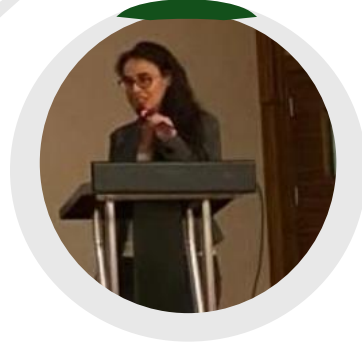
## COLLECTIVE MEMBERS IA (CMIA)
