### SEERC vs NON SEERC



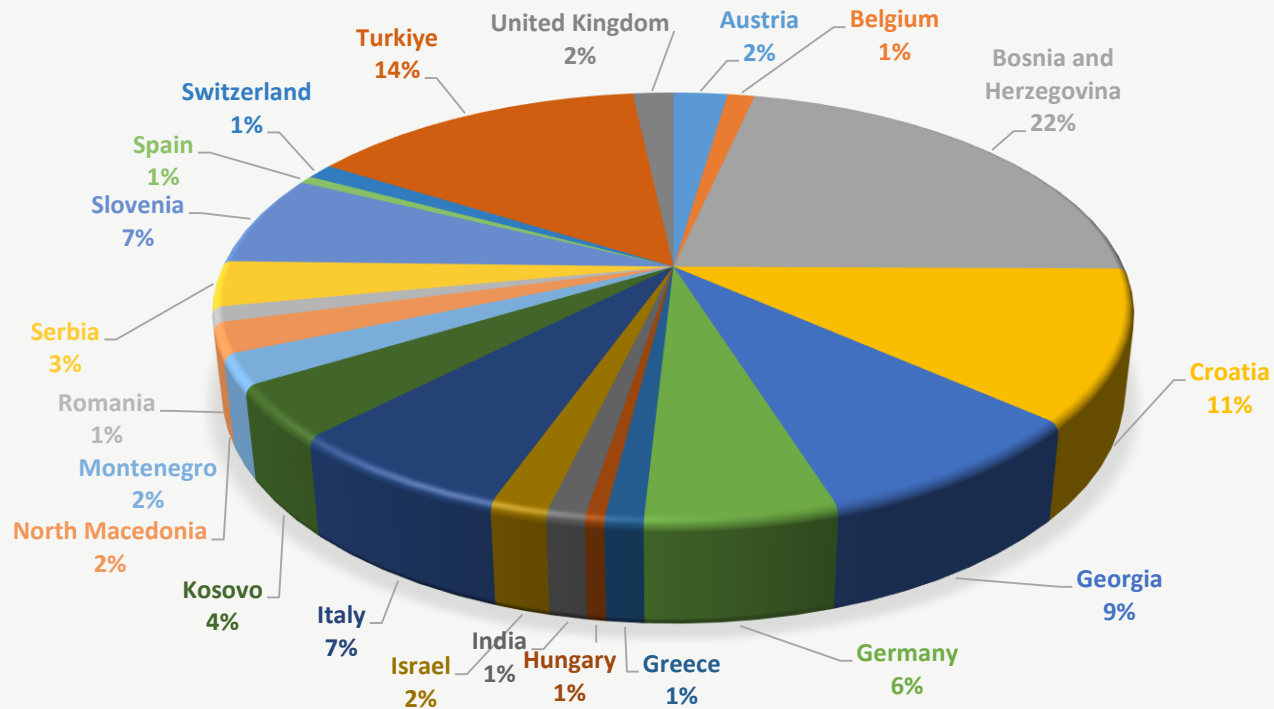
#### The largest number of submissions:

## Suggestions Given to Technical Chairs and Co-chairs

Proposed conclusions of the SEERC TAC MEETING in Rome, January 2025.

1. that all submitted synopses be accepted, with the possible reallocation of some of the synopses to another (appropriate) Topic
2. that the Conference Organizer, i.e. BHK CIGRE, will ensure adequate spatial and human capacities for poster presentation of papers for all 4 main Topics, even in cases where the number of poster presentations exceeds 20 or 40 posters per topic
3. that a special "general" topic be formed, which will bear the name, e.g. Functionality of power systems and equipment, in which papers would be presented orally or in the form of posters, which do not fit into any of the four Conference topics, whereby these are papers that are of interest to CIGRE and which must be positively evaluated by the reviewer
4. that the Conference Organizer, i.e. BHK CIGRE, will ensure adequate spatial and human capacities for poster presentation of papers from the so-called "PETE" Topics
5. that the Conference Organizer, i.e. BHK CIGRE, together with other SEERC members, will select more Co-chairs for the topics, given that the topics received the most applications (64)
6. that we believe that the classification of papers into presentations and poster presentations at this stage is not justified, because there is a considerable probability that some of these papers will not be written at all, and that some that are written may not be accepted or will be accepted but without the expected quality, and that papers for oral or poster presentations should be classified only when they are received in full text and revised
7. That two applications which arrive at the SEERC email the day after the deadline for submitting applications be taken into consideration.
