Focus on: Strategy up to 2030 (if possible vision up to 2050)...Electricity sector

The member states of EU are obliged to submit National energy-climate plans (NECP) up to 2030 before end of 2019. They are required to develop an integrated NECP that covers the following dimensions (energy policy):

- Decarbonization (emissions of GHG, penetration of RES in %), Energy security,
- Energy efficiency, Internal market design and competition,
- Research and innovation level plans.

The other eight SEERC members also have own strategies for energy sector development up to 2030 or up to 2050. This is the opportunity for SEERC to start discussions about our regional possibilities and development plans, particularly **in the electric power sector** for topics like new plans for RES, integration approaches, new extensions of network at distribution and transmission level, new cooperation between countries in region, etc. (Remember: Cigre is not only Transmission but includes the whole electric power system including Distribution, Generation, Active customers, Market issues and Regulation).

Each country's contribution should include:

- Demand forecast up to 2030, or possibly up to 2050.
- Development of RES (wind, solar, other sources), or/and other generation resources,
- Gas infrastructure or other sources to balancing ramp demand,
- Plans for decarbonization, energy efficiency, electricity import/export balances, level of penetration of e-mobility, non-ETS emissions.
- New investments in networks, eventually plans of regional cooperation.

Time for presentation is limited to 15-20 minutes.
